








Rationale

- Youth exclusion from project design, Implementation and evaluation reducing trust and social capital between young people and government
- Risk of embezzlement of fiscal stimuli and emergency rescue packages
- No anti-corruption safeguards initiating oversight
- Top down approach to Covid-19 mitigation ignoring communities
- Shrinking civic space
- Need for comparative researches that are context specific and gender responsive
- Answer social accountability patient questions
- Collect, analyse global, regional and country data on Covid-19 mitigation
- How service users influence delivery
- Follow money, resource and policies on Covid-19
- Empowerment of youth as social accountability facilitators

- ➤ A change or response by Government as a result of its interaction with citizens.
- Improved capacity of male and female youth in enhancing democratic accountability.
