

# e-Course on Gender Mainstreaming and Budgeting

## Learning Objectives

The objectives of the training is to make participants a) understand the basic concepts of gender and development; b) understand and apply the processes and tools of analyzing existing gender roles, structures and attitudes in relations to decision making at national, regional, community and organizational levels ; c) comprehend and operationalize tools of mainstreaming gender in sector policies, strategies, and programs/projects; and d) analyze national and local government budgets to establish the differential impacts of revenue raising and expenditures on women and men and on different groups of women and men.

The training will cover various topics including understanding the basic concepts of gender and development; gender issues in organizations; sex disaggregated data and gender analytical information; gender budgeting (concepts, issues and experiences); gender auditing; mainstreaming gender in sector policies, strategies and programmes/ projects (tools, processes and methods of analysis).

## Content and Structure

The course will cover various topics including

1. Basic Concepts of Gender and Development
2. Gender Issues in Organisations
3. Sex Disaggregated Data and gender Analytical Information
4. Gender Budgeting and Auditing (Concepts, Issues and Experiences)
5. Mainstreaming Gender in Sector Policies, Strategies and Programmes (Tools, Processes and Methods of Analysis)

## Methodology

The course is self-paced and it is facilitated by well know professionals in the region and the Diaspora, and it is divided into modules provided to help you reach the overall learning objectives. The modules are consecutive and you have to follow the order to complete the course; in addition all modules must be passed to receive a certificate of completion. Each module contains an interactive lesson and a quiz.

The interactive lessons are provided with the purpose of achieving the specific learning objectives per module, and contain pages of lessons supported by case studies, videos, external links and exercises. A glossary of terms is also provided. You have to complete the quizzes at the end of each lesson to move to the next lesson. The quizzes assess the achievement of the learning objectives for each lesson. Each quiz can be attempted a maximum of three times. Once the quizzes are passed with at least 70% each, the learner has successfully completed the e-course and a certificate of completion signed by the course facilitators and the Executive Director of OSSREA will be directly mailed to the physical address you supplied during registration.

Participants will be requested to provide feedback on the course by filling a feedback form which can be accessed from the e-learning system.
